

CONGRESSWOMAN ANNIE KUSTER VISITS SUMMIT BY MORRISON

Kuster Praises Care Offered, Jobs Created by White Mountains' New Senior Living Community

WHITEFIELD, N.H. – A day before taking part in a panel addressing the healthcare workforce shortages in the North Country, Congresswoman Annie Kuster (NH-02) toured Summit by Morrison, where 30 new jobs have been created, many in health services.

Summit by Morrison is the region's newest senior living community, with a 25-acre campus that includes 14 Independent Living cottages, 33 Independent Living apartments, 24 Assisted Living apartments and 12 apartments for residents who require Memory Care.

"Summit is a great opportunity for people who want to stay in the North Country as they age," Kuster said during her August 23 visit. "Residents know that they are well cared for, they're safe, and they have wonderful people looking out for them. I think it will really make a difference by giving residents a good quality of life and their families peace of mind."

Kuster has been out front trying to meet the challenges associated with caring for people suffering from Alzheimer's and other Memory Care issues. She is a co-sponsor of two acts supporting the prevention, detection and diagnosis of Alzheimer's and other causes of dementia.

Summit by Morrison was developed by The Morrison Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing Care (The Morrison) to create the region's only full continuum of care for seniors and is located less than a mile from The Morrison, which has been providing healthcare to the North Country since 1903.
